#### **Public Comments:**

- Mary Anne Mosely, a minor, was upset that she could not use the adult section of the library to retrieve a cookbook. She felt that the library's closing of the adult stacks was beyond the scope of the new Idaho code 18-1517B and read the passages in the code that described obscene content.
- Mark Mosely was unhappy with the library functionality. He told the board they would still be held accountable for disseminating offensive materials, and said he would be encouraging parents to contact the state police.
- Eileen Wenzle, a minor, was with Mary Anne to find the cookbook. She was confused as to why the law applied to all materials in the adult section.
- Tim Wilson spoke, explaining why the vague language of the law made it possible to broadly interpret section 18-1517B 2(c) "Any other material harmful to minors" and that the library was taking a conservative approach to the law until larger library districts could help the state better define the boundaries.
- Lynn Silva spoke as well, saying that the librarians were doing the best they could with a difficult situation.
